HCC POOL RULES

With summer underway, I would like to welcome all Halifax Country Club members to the pool. Please note the following rules and regulations regarding its use:

- The Pool is now open. Pool Hours: 10:00 am- 10:00 pm Lifeguards will be on duty 10:00 am- 5:00 pm. No lifeguard, swim at your own risk.
- Please sign in upon arrival and pay the required fees, if applicable.
- Guest days for **in-county guests accompanied by a member** are **Tuesday and Thursday.** There is a \$5 fee per guest. This rule pertains to evening hours as well.
- Out of county guests accompanied by a member may visit the pool **14** days per season with no charge. Please have them sign in each visit.
- Children ages 11 years and under must be accompanied by a parent or adult member/babysitter.
- Children ages 12 years or older may visit the pool without adult supervision during lifeguard hours, and, on guest day, may bring a guest 12 years or older.
- Children ages 14 and over are allowed to visit the pool 5:00-10:00 pm without adult supervision. Swim at your own risk.
- Babysitter passes may be purchased in the Clubhouse for \$100 per family for non-member babysitters. Babysitter passes may not be purchased for non-or-joint-custodial parents and can only be used when they are with the child they are babysitting.

• Birthday Parties

- The pool is available for members to host Birthday parties during the hours of **5:00-9:00 pm** for a \$50 fee. The fee includes up to 10 non-member guests. An additional \$13 fee is required each hour for the lifeguard. Pay directly to the lifeguards \$13 cash an hour. Lifeguards at birthday parties are mandatory. Birthday parties can be scheduled by calling or texting Bill Blanks @ 434-579-5517. Please pay Lee Tysinger in the clubhouse for the pool fee and lifeguard fees should be paid directly to the lifeguard.
- Music is available through Alexa located underneath the picnic shelter. People should be 18 years old or older to turn on the TV or play music. The volume should be at a level where you can speak without raising your voice to the person beside you. Explicit music shall not be played at the pool. Please be courteous and mindful of the members around you that just want to relax and enjoy their day.

As you enjoy the pool this season, please be respectful of the pool area and lifeguards by throwing away your trash and keeping the pool area tidy. Please close umbrellas prior to leaving the pool. Members are expected to follow all rules and regulations. Abuse of these rules and regulations may result in a suspension of membership/pool privileges. Additionally, the pool will be monitored by the Halifax County Sheriff's Department on a regular basis during the evening hours, and anyone found on the premises after 11:00 pm maybe be charged with trespassing, member or not.

We hope that by providing these rules and regulations everyone will have an enjoyable and safe summer at the pool.
